

Face-to-Face

This is a one-on-one or group meeting with a tutor in the Writing Center.

- In person (Library BA 527)
- Real-time (synchronous)
- Must be present in person
- Bring a copy of your paper or your computer
- Go to the top (5th floor) of the library to BA 527 (next to the conference room and Speech Center)
- Will receive verbal and written feedback on your paper during your appointment



Best if you want to meet in person to receive direct feedback and ask the tutor questions.

eTutoring (Online)

This is an online appointment where a tutor will write comments and send the paper back to you.

- Online
- Not real-time (asynchronous)
- Do not need to be present
- Attach your paper and any other materials, such as rubrics, online
- Go to the online scheduler and edit your appointment to add the paper at a later time; simply choose a file to attach at the bottom of the form.
- Will receive written feedback on your paper under “Attached Files” at the bottom of your appointment form.



Best if you can't be there and you do not have time to work with a tutor.

Chat (Online)

This is a real-time online chat appointment with a tutor.

- Online
- Real-time (synchronous)
- Must be present online
- Attach your paper in the chat whiteboard space
- Go to your appointment form and click “Start to Join Online Consultation”
- Will receive verbal and written feedback as you talk online with your tutor, so long as you and the tutor have audio/video features enabled on your device



Best if you are off campus but have time to talk with a tutor and have specific questions.
