Integrated Health Therapist or Counselor

- Behavioral modification, counseling and support
- Provides psychosocial assessment
- Onsite immediate crisis assessment, intervention, and coordination with primary care team
- Locates & links patients to community-based resources
- Acts as a consultant to the clinic
- Performs brief, limited follow-up visits with selected patients
- Serves as a liaison between Primary Care & Psychiatry/Psychology



Behavioral Health Therapist or Counselor

- Works with a range of patient populations and presenting issues
- Has total independence and responsibility for patient well-being
- Provides diagnostic assessment, onsite crisis assessment and intervention
- Determines need for ongoing care according to level of clinical ability, medical, and psychosocial complexity
- Variety of settings: clinic, community, residential

Social Worker

- Serves as a member of the interdisciplinary team
- Assists with social, emotional and economical concerns of patients/clients/residents and families/caregivers
- Provides crisis intervention and assists families in understanding the implications and complexities of medical situations
- Depending on department may be providing social services for donors and transplant recipients



What do we do?

- Center-based programs designed specifically for pre-school to school-age children (~2-11 years old) who have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder or a related condition
- Clients receive 1 to 20+ hours of services per week
- A multi-disciplinary approach within a mental health model (MH, OT, SLP)
- Family is an integral part of our treatment team!

Treatment Methods

We utilize components of a variety of evidence-based practices throughout the treatment day, but our primary focus is developmental, relationship, and play-based intervention including, but not limited to:

- DIR/Floortime (The Greenspan Floortime Approach)
 - Our clinicians are trained and certified in this approach through the Floortime Center®


