This full semester course includes an extended spring break at the Gerace Research Centre, located on San Salvador Island. Prior to travel, students will learn about marine and tropical island ecosystems and organisms they will see when abroad and design a research project to carry out on the island. Days on the island will include **snorkeling in coral reef and sea grass meadows, hiking through tropical scrub forests, exploring limestone caves, and exploring historic sites**, all while carrying out research projects.
