View your degree audit to see which of your program requirements are completed, in-progress, and still needed.

Degree Audit is a self-directed, automatic planning tool that helps you track your progress toward completing an academic program (degree, diploma, or certificate) and uses the most up-to-date information available, including transfer courses, from the student record system.

- Access Degree Audit in the [Minnesota State Student Planner](#) through your [Student eServices](#) account on any device connected to the internet.
- Designed with degree completion in mind.
- Real time integration with the student information system and student records.
- Transfer work is articulated and displays on the audit.
- Allows students and advisors to view academic progress toward declared and 'what-if' majors.
- Students and advisors have access to the same information in the same application.
- You may also have access to [Graduation Planner and Schedule Builder](#).

Check your audit as often as needed:

- Before you register for classes to see which courses you still need.
- After you register for classes to check that the courses you registered for meet your program requirements.
- After your grades are posted to make sure the grades are correct and meet your requirements.
