## Additional Licensure: Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) Grades K-12

This advising guide is for teacher candidates who already hold a tier 3 or 4 MN professional license. The Standards of effective practice have been met with initial licensure. Instead of a 12-week student teaching placement, there will be a minimum 80-hour practicum after all coursework has been completed.

Required preparation includes two years of high school foreign language or one year of foreign language in a post-secondary setting. This is for MN licensure per the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board. Evidence of this will be required when applying for licensure.

MTLE tests required for this major: English as a Second Language K-12 Content test (2 subtests) prior to licensure. Basic skills tests in Reading, Writing, Math are not required until applying for <u>Tier 4 licensure</u>. More information about licensure testing information can be found on PELSB's website.
